A small PPE located in the north of the commune of Boudry (in the neverlands), requested a local façade specialist for the realization of a part of facade in photovoltaic panels. The objective was to completely blend in a few dozen square meters of panels to power the heat pump and the common premises with the rest of the plastered façade.

The white film from [Solaxess](#) could be integrated during the PV-panels manufacturing. The colour of the whole building is completely uniform and has been working to satisfaction for several months, the company says.
